Keystone Education Yields Success (KEYS)

What is KEYS?

Keystone Education Yields Success (KEYS) is a collaborative program between the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) and all Pennsylvania community colleges. KEYS is designed to assist recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) attend community college and ensure the successful completion of the students' courses.

How do I enroll?

Students currently enrolled at Penn Highlands and who are receiving SNAP should contact the **KEYS Office** at **814.262.6420**. TANF recipients who would like to enroll should contact their County Assistance Office for referral to the KEYS Program.

What are the goals?

- To ensure students are attending and participating in school with the intent of graduating with a credit-bearing certificate, associate degree, or completion of non-credit bearing certificate.
- To provide services and support necessary to assist students in completing their educational activities.
- To help students maintain a GPA of 2.0 or better.
- To serve as the liaison between the student and the County Assistance Office.
- To ensure students are meeting the minimum eligibility requirements to qualify for County Assistance Office program extensions.
